OTHER INFORMATION:

The booster station is 95% complete and will be on line in March. This project provides added pressure so that we can use the majority of water in the 72' tall, 290,000-gallon tank if needed in the lower areas of the water system. Currently we are only able to use the top 4' due to pressures. A fire pump is also installed in the new booster station.

Work on the 1 million gallon storage tank is 25% complete; we are in hopes of starting construction this fall.

Important reminder to those homeowners who have backflow assemblies. The annual test of your backflow device is due by April 30th. This is a yearly inspection required by the Washington State Department of Health and Roosevelt Water Association, Inc. WAC 246-290-490. A brochure "Cross Connections in Household Plumbing" is posted on our website, please take time to read this to understand better how a cross connection can be prevented. We also have information on our website on cross connection. We have placed a "Residential Survey" form on our website, if you would like either one mailed to you please call or write.

Flushing of the main water lines will start in April and continue into late May. Flushing will be done on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays from 9:00am-3:00pm, discolored (dirty) water and low water pressure can be expected during flushing.
